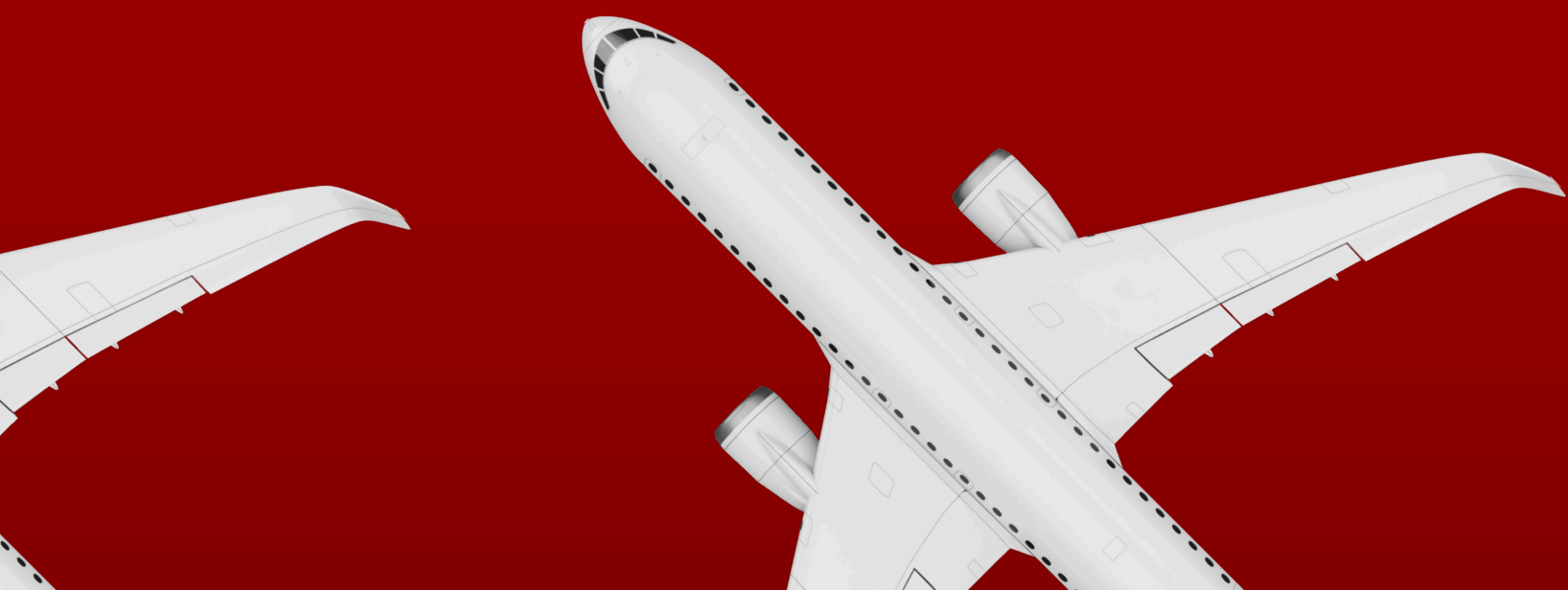
# **Airlines are ideal for identity-based attacks:**

# Scattered Spider exploits:

- 
- **Social engineering** – convincing help desks
  - **MFA bypass** – SIM swaps, fatigue attacks
  - **Vendor infiltration** – weak contractor security





## **The Challenge:**

An attacker poses as a pilot who lost access during a layover. Traditional help desks reset accounts.

## **The Defense:**

Identity-first security. No biometric match, no access. Attack stopped.
